

# THE INTERACTIVE SOVEREIGN SOCIETY and the Interactive Electoral System

*“Collectively developing and respecting a set of principles of lawful conduct”*

If an individual is recognized by your government as having laws based on a different constitution than the one upon which the laws you follow are based, would you wish to have a say in what these laws are?

Read the Constitution and Summation of Principles for the Interactive Sovereign Society (ISS). Meet the Society’s interactively elected Prime Representative and inform her that you may wish to be regarded as a member.

You may nonetheless wish to read the “yes” response to this question to see how such a process is currently functioning in Canada.

If you decide to be a member, consider whether you would prefer ISS laws to be the only laws you would be required to follow, or whether you wish to be a dual consenting citizen, responsible to both the ISS laws and the Crown’s.

You can stop reading here but please consider informing others of the existence of the Society so that they too may contemplate membership and thus help test, hone and perpetuate this exceedingly more equitable and accountable model and take it to the grand scale.

**SOVEREIGN ONLY**

Approach the Federal Court of Canada with an application to be recognized by the Crown as having made a sovereign choice of a Constitution. The Interactive Sovereign Society will help you to achieve this, as other members have.

Do you believe that the ISS laws hold its members to a standard of conduct that is equally satisfactory to you as the Crown’s standards?
